What is the Mobile Optimist Sailing School?



An exciting learn-to-sail program for youth aged 6 -15 years. The program is five days long and runs from 9:00 to 3:30 each day. The aim of the program is to provide a safe and fun environment in which to learn the basics of water safety through sailing and kayaking. The staff are professionally trained and certified Canadian Yachting Association coaches.

What Should I Bring to the MOSS?

BC Sailing in partnership with your local sailing club will offer this program in your local area. They will provide all the necessary equipment to make it a success. The sailors will need to bring a water bottle, lunch, sunscreen, closed-toe shoes (old runners or Aqua socks), a change of clothes, a towel, and a hat. Life-jackets will be provided.

Pleasure Craft Operator's Card Course



The PCOC card is required by law to operate a motorized pleasure craft under 4m in length. A 3-hr seminar with exam will ensure each participant becomes a safe and responsible power-boat operator. This is a great seminar for the entire family!
