

Scott McAdam Memorial Scholarship  
October 31, 1957 to September 24, 2001

Scott first came to the North as a Hudson Bay Company employee in the 80's. He initially started out as a trainee and commitment to hard work, honesty and treating people fairly helped him advance to become a store manager. In January 1991, he enrolled in Arctic College and graduated from the Recreation Leader Program in 1992. As his career advanced in the recreation field, Scott and his family moved throughout the Northwest Territories. In May of 1998, they made Fort Simpson their home.

Scott was the Recreation Coordinator for the Village of Fort Simpson for 3 ½ years. He was very active as a volunteer; he was the Arctic Winter Games Regional Coordinator for the Mackenzie Region for 2 sets of Games and a member of the Sport North Games Committee for 2 years. Scott was also involved with the NWT Recreation & Parks Association as a board member for several years. In addition to this, he helped out in the community by volunteering in a variety of different capacities.
