Responsibilities

- Monitors equipment budget.
- Inventories all new equipment coming into team.
- Travels on the road to away games with the team.
- Helps prepare rink and team for home game operations.
- Sharpens players' skates on practice nights and game nights.
- Interacts with major manufacturer in regards to equipment ordering and contract negotiations.
